The Monadnock Regional School District is a diverse district of multiple elementary school buildings of various sizes and ages. Most have numerous facility and space deficiencies including life safety issues and handicap inaccessibility.

The proposed project is to consolidate four of the schools into two. There would be additions to Mt Caesar Elementary School to house students from the northern part of the district and a New Elementary school located strategically to house students from the southern part of the district. This project would simultaneously solve current deficiencies plus increase efficiencies.
